Something new in February, come join us for pizza and drink for the February meeting. This will be an open meeting with no program, just an opportunity to talk Ham Radio with friends.

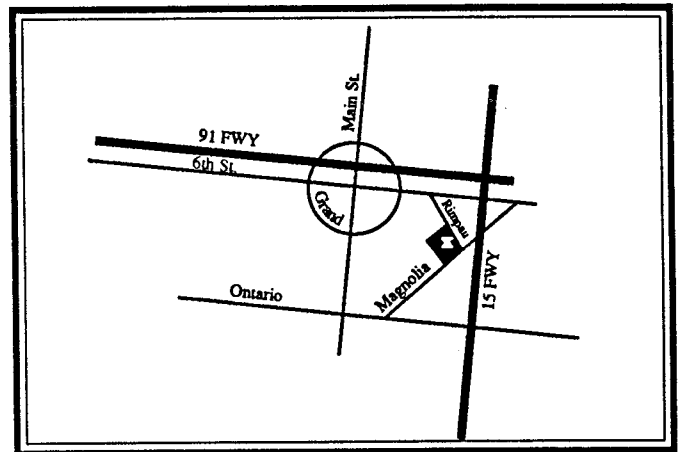

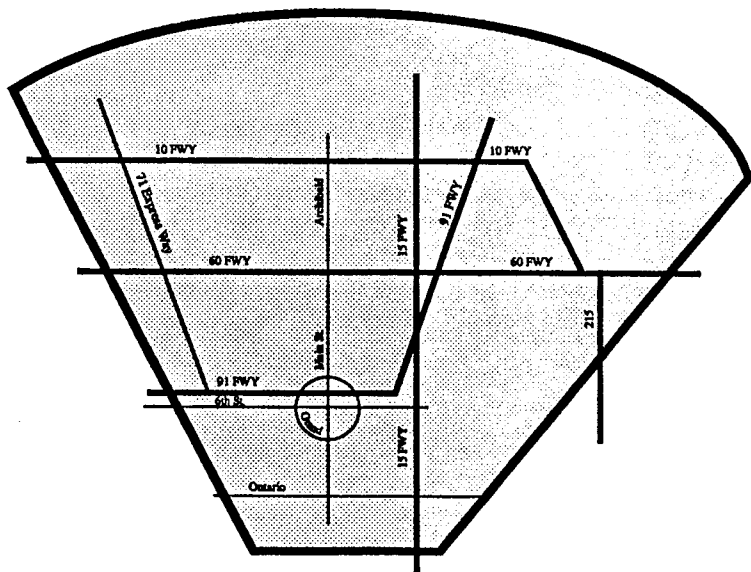
This is to announce the availability for use of a local repeater station in Corona by the Corona-Norco Amateur Radio Club effective immediately for both personal and club transmissions.

The frequency is 224.700 with down offset and utilizing a PL of 107.2 (1B/14). The reception is directed northward from the southern limits of the city limit and has an operating range into San Bernardino County with occasional gray spots. It receives well from Hwy 71 to the West to the Moreno valley area to the East. It loses signal at Hwy 91 and Hwy 71 to the West and Hwy 15 at Ontario Avenue to the East. In between, is good communication.

This repeater is an open machine and encourages RACES, Red Cross, and club event use. Special consideration is given for special event activities. It IDs KB6JVA (both CW and Voice) with occasional special announcements in it's ID.

A closed patch is available to local users with the interest or need and also has a Voice Mail Box available. It will operate as a remote and has not only 220 Mhz capability, but also can have outputs of 2-meter, 440, and 10-meter FM all remotely controlled. When 146.535 (simplex) is programmed, it acknowledges with CNARC to let the programmer know the correct frequency has been selected (by use of a preset MACRO). The repeater utilized an Acc 850 controller.

There are three control operators: KB6JVA (Don), KN6ONO (Rob), and KB6DOL (Ed). Any one of them will be happy to answer any questions you may have or requests not mentioned above. (KB6DOL is listed in listed in your club roster for phone and address information).

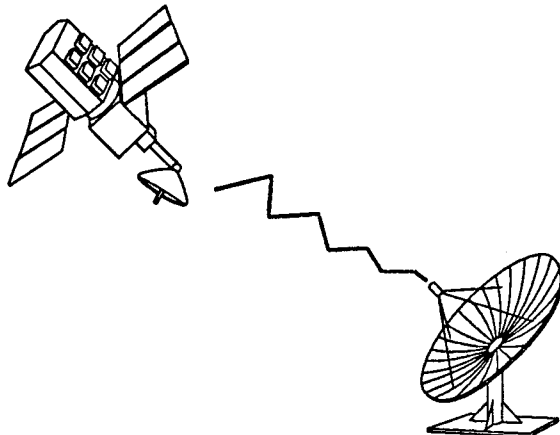
