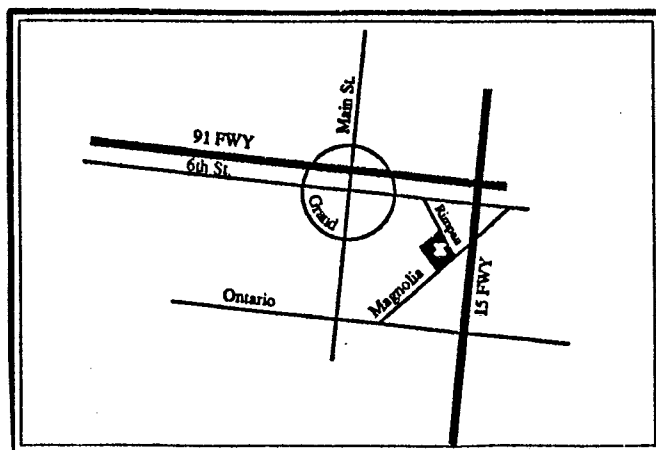
Heard any good DX lately?


